

7 FACTS YOU DIDN'T KNOW ABOUT SLOVAKIA:

- 1. Slovakia boasts a Guinness World Record for the largest ice cave in the world, the Dobšinská Ice Cave, with spectacular ice formations that are a sight to behold.
- 2. Bratislava, the capital of Slovakia, is one of the only capitals in the world that borders two other countries: Austria and Hungary.
- 3. The country is home to the oldest national park in Central Europe, the Tatra National Park, which boasts stunning alpine scenery and diverse wildlife, including the elusive Tatra chamois.
- 4. The country is famous for its rich spa culture, with over 1,200 mineral springs and thermal spas where visitors can relax and rejuvenate.
- 5. In the town of Kremnica, visitors can see the world's oldest continuously operating mint, which has been producing coins since 1328.
- Slovakia is a land of ancient castles, with over 100 of them scattered throughout the country. The most famous is Spiš Castle, one of the largest castle complexes in Europe.
- 7. Slovak folklore is rich in mythical creatures, including the "čert" (devil) and "kriváň" (a mythical mountain). Legends and stories about these creatures are still passed down through generations.





WELCOME TO THE SLOVAK KARTING CENTER

SLOVAK KARTING CENTER is a part of the SLOVAKIA RING motorsport complex. It features the CIK-FIA homologated race track in Slovak Republic. Build in 2019, it belongs to the most visited and wanted area of the SLOVAKIA RING.

The track can be driven in 5 different layouts, moreover even nightime as the whole race track is artificially lighted. The central building offers everything for any kind of event or race related to go-karts, along with briefing rooms, dress room, registration, bar, race control and offices.





WHAT TO SEE AND DO

SLOVAKIA RING

WORLD-CLASS SLOVAK CIRCUIT

SLOVAKIA RING is the first and only race track in Slovakia build in 2009. It is a professional and versatile motor sport facility with the Grade II FIA Circuit License and the FIM circuit license.

The track parameters make SLOVAKIA RING one of the longest (5922m) and safiest permanent circuits in Europe. It is technically demanding even for the most experienced drivers, the large run-off areas provide maximum safety.

We hosted series like World Touring Car Championship, Blancpain GT, ADAC GT Master, Endurance World Championship (EWC), European Truck Racing Championship, FIA CEZ Rallycross and many more.

You can enter the paddock and main grandstand (A) between 9am - 8pm, entry is free of charge.

TRACK WALK

We are giving you an unique opportunity to explore our race track on your own. Take your bike, scooter (electric included), inline skates, skateboards or experience our 6 km long race track on foot. No registration needed, just come over to track walk point and enjoy, entry is free of charge.

Date/time: Friday (31.5.) from 6pm to 8.30pm



MALKIA PARK



First and the biggest private ZOO in Slovakia is right next door to the Slovak Karting Center – 5 min walk from the main building.

On an area of 7.2 ha, you will find more than 260 specimens, 69 different species of animals. We provide shelter to more than 50 felines (lions, tigers, leopards, jaguars, lynx, cougars, cheetahs).

In Slovakia, we are the only ones with painted dogs, spotted hyenas, yellow mongoose and honey badgers. Experience the animals in action in their natural behavior every weekend during guided feeding at 11am and 2.30pm.

Allow please at least 1,5 hour for a full tour through the park.

MILITARY MUSEUM

THERMALPARK DUNAJSKÁ STREDA

Thermalpark Dunajská Streda is one of the most popular and most visited recreational resorts in southern Slovakia. It offers perfect relaxation for all ages in a beautiful environment in the heart of Rye Island.

With spread over 18 hectares, the resort features four indoor and six outdoor pools for swimming. Thermal water with temperatures up to 39°C has beneficial effects on the musculoskeletal system.
